



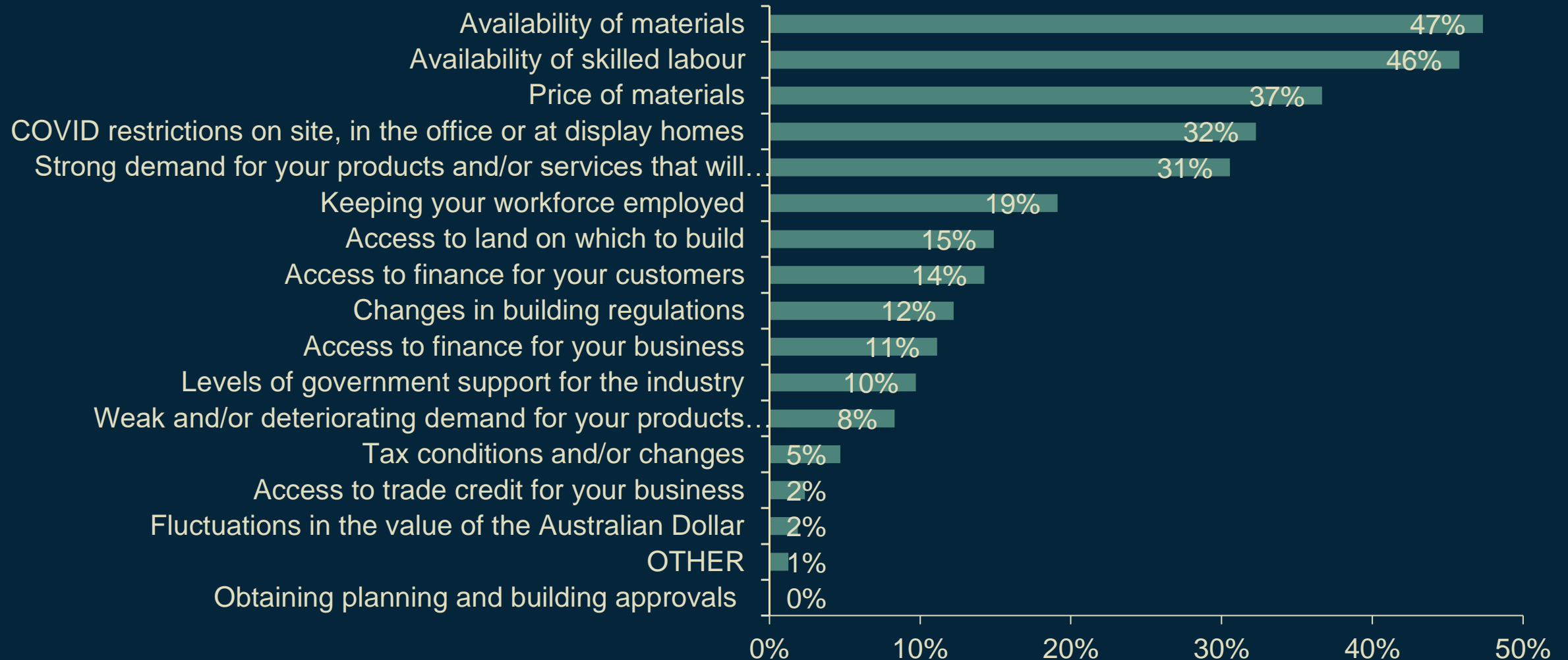

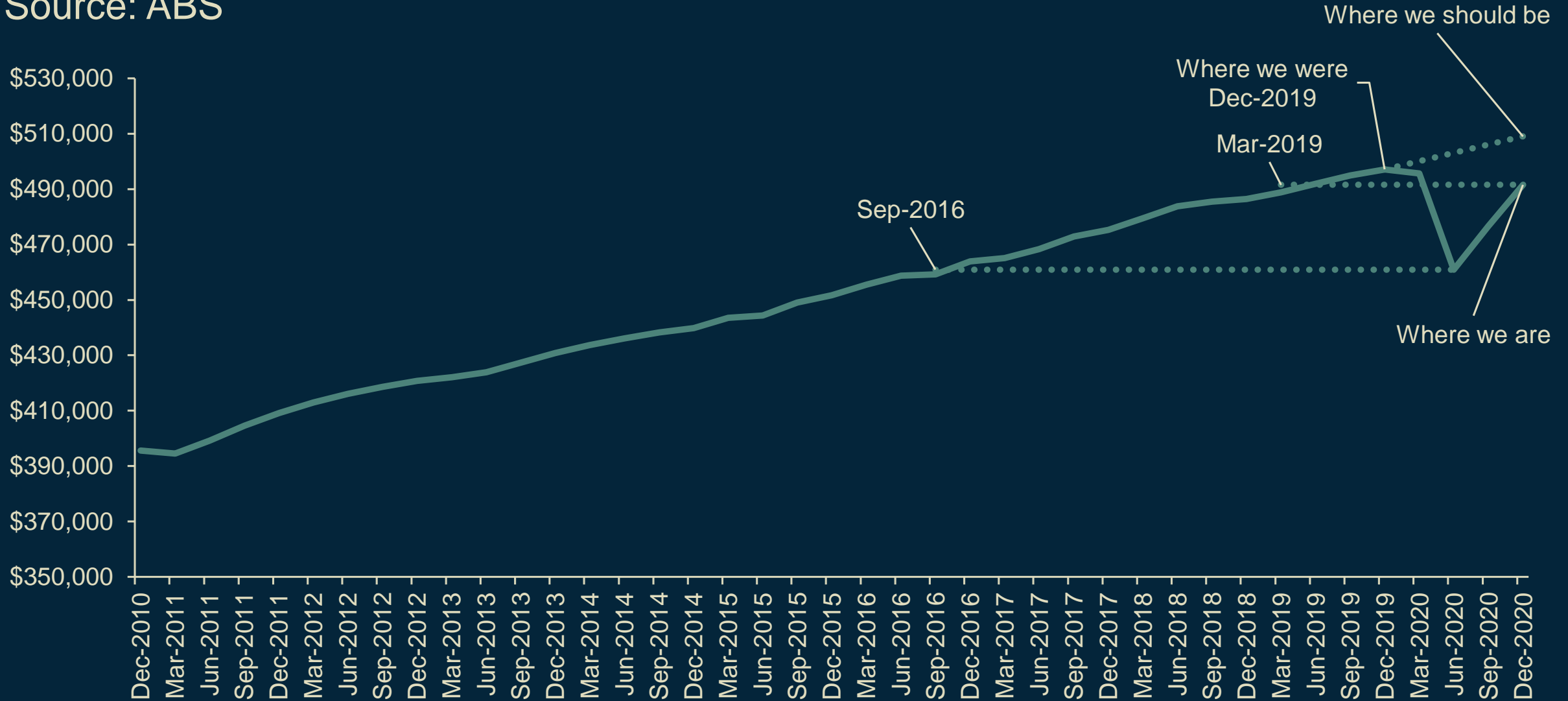
What were the greatest pressure points for your business and its operations this year (2020/21)?

# GDP: The Bungy Effect

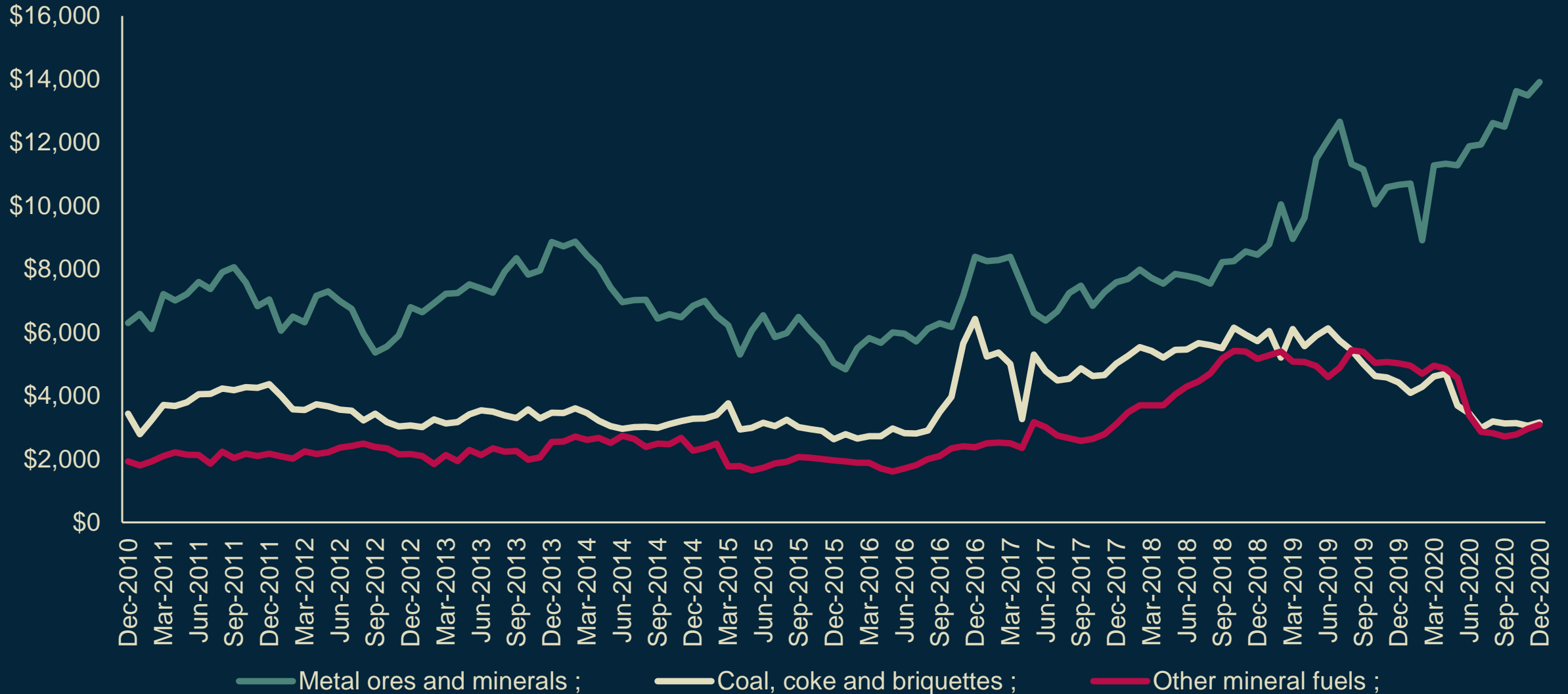
Gross Domestic Product, Quarterly

## Mining Goods Exports

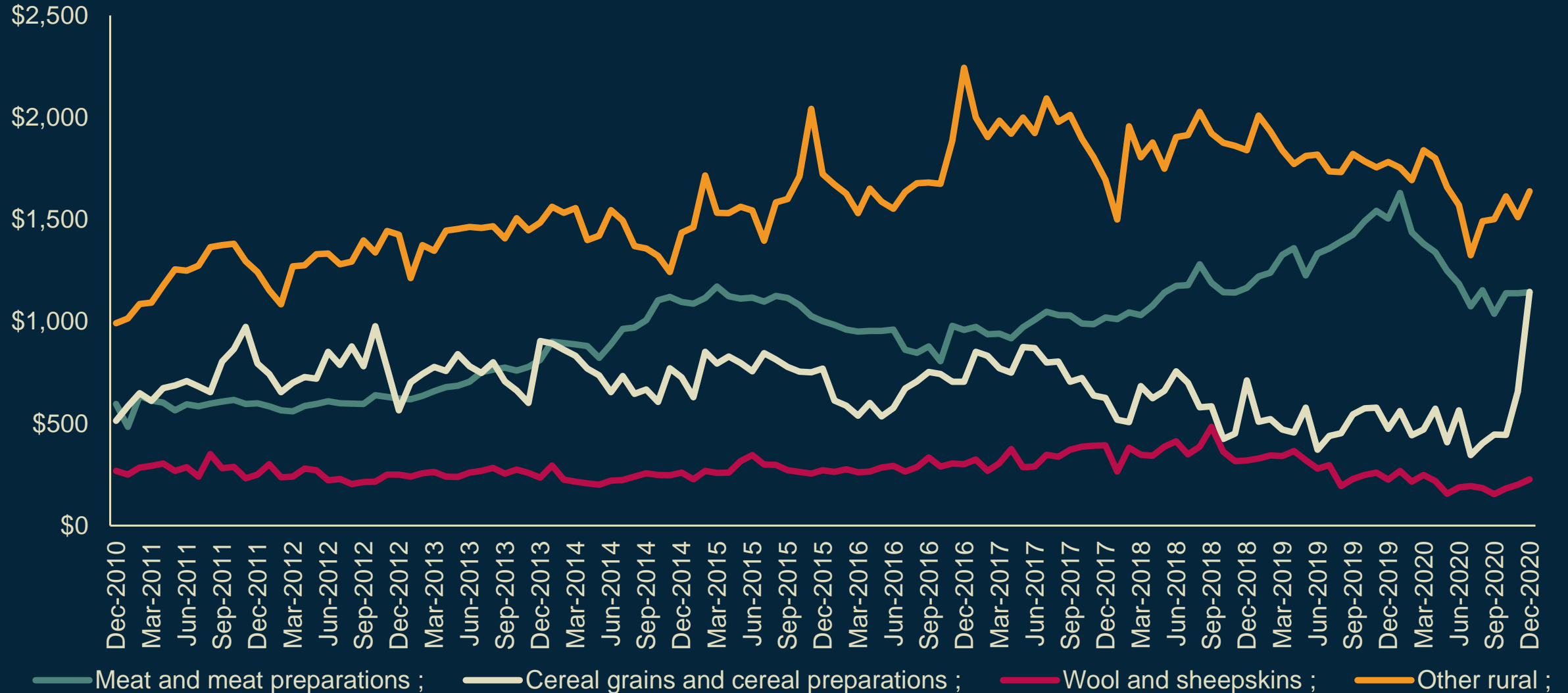

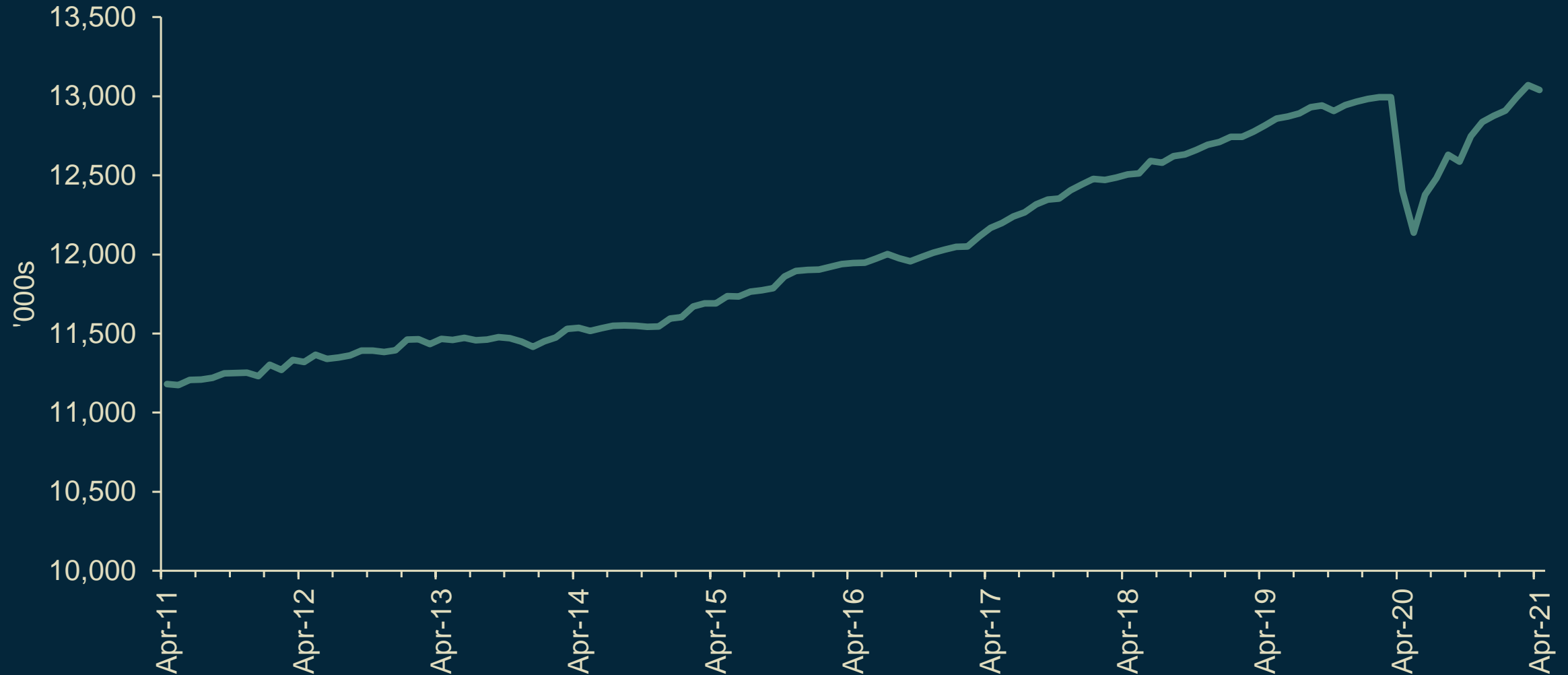


# Unemployment = 5.6%



## Total Persons Employed - Australia

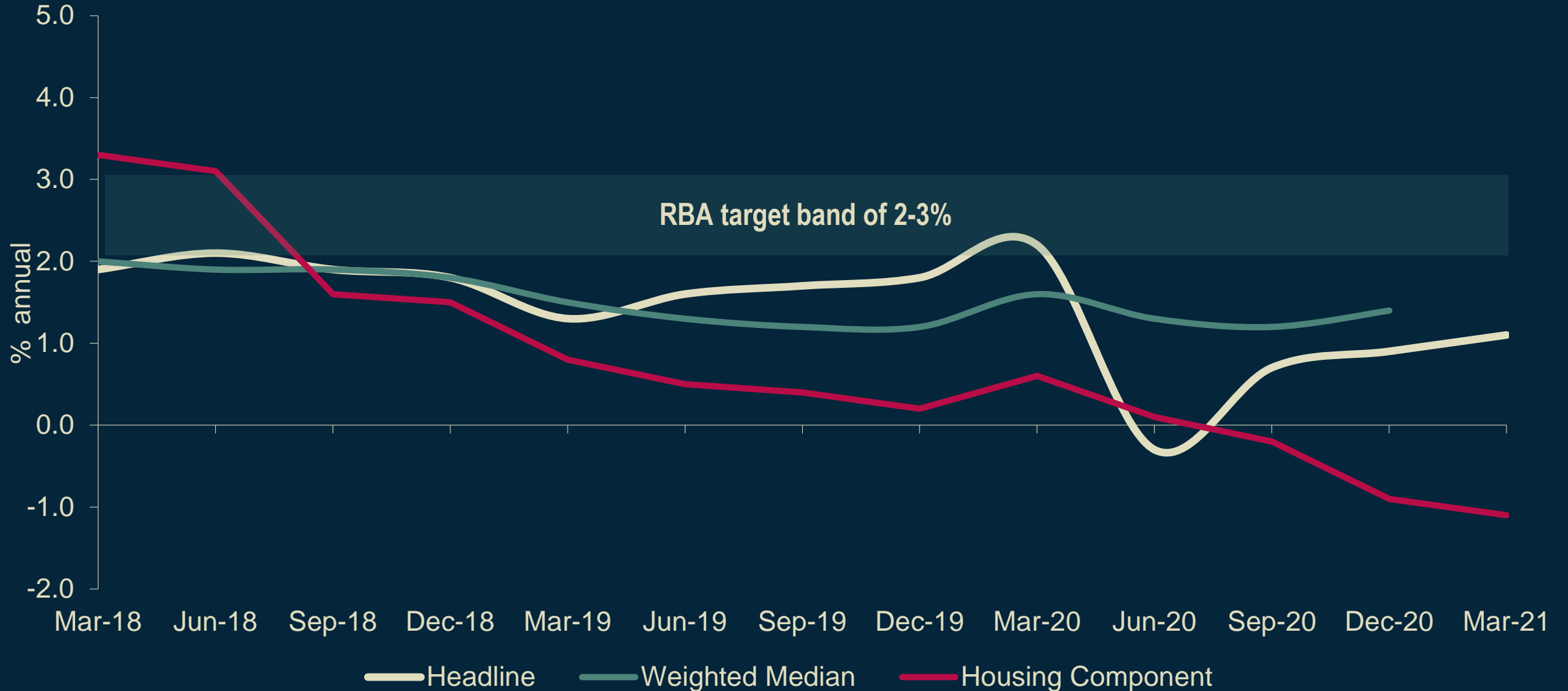

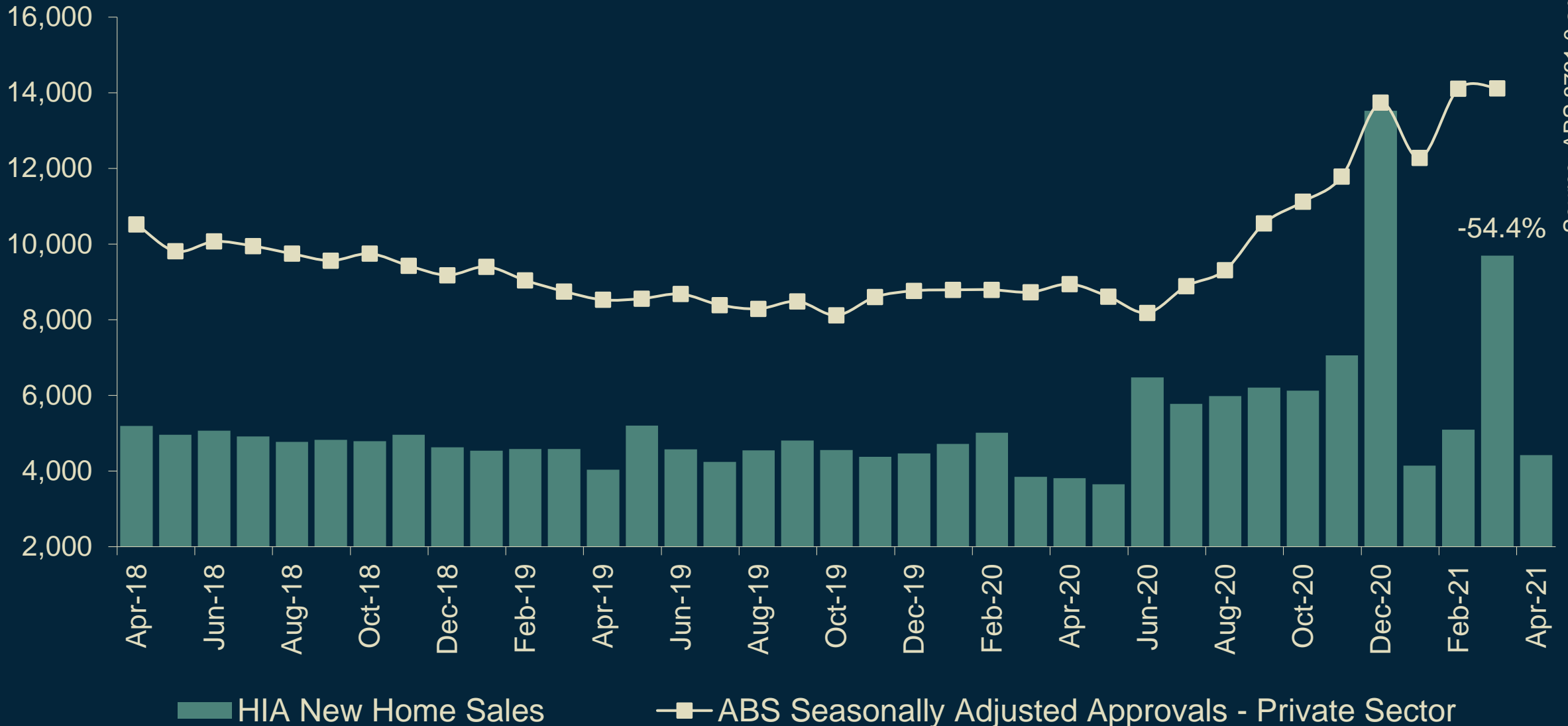

## Private New House Sales - Australia (SEASONALLY ADJUSTED)

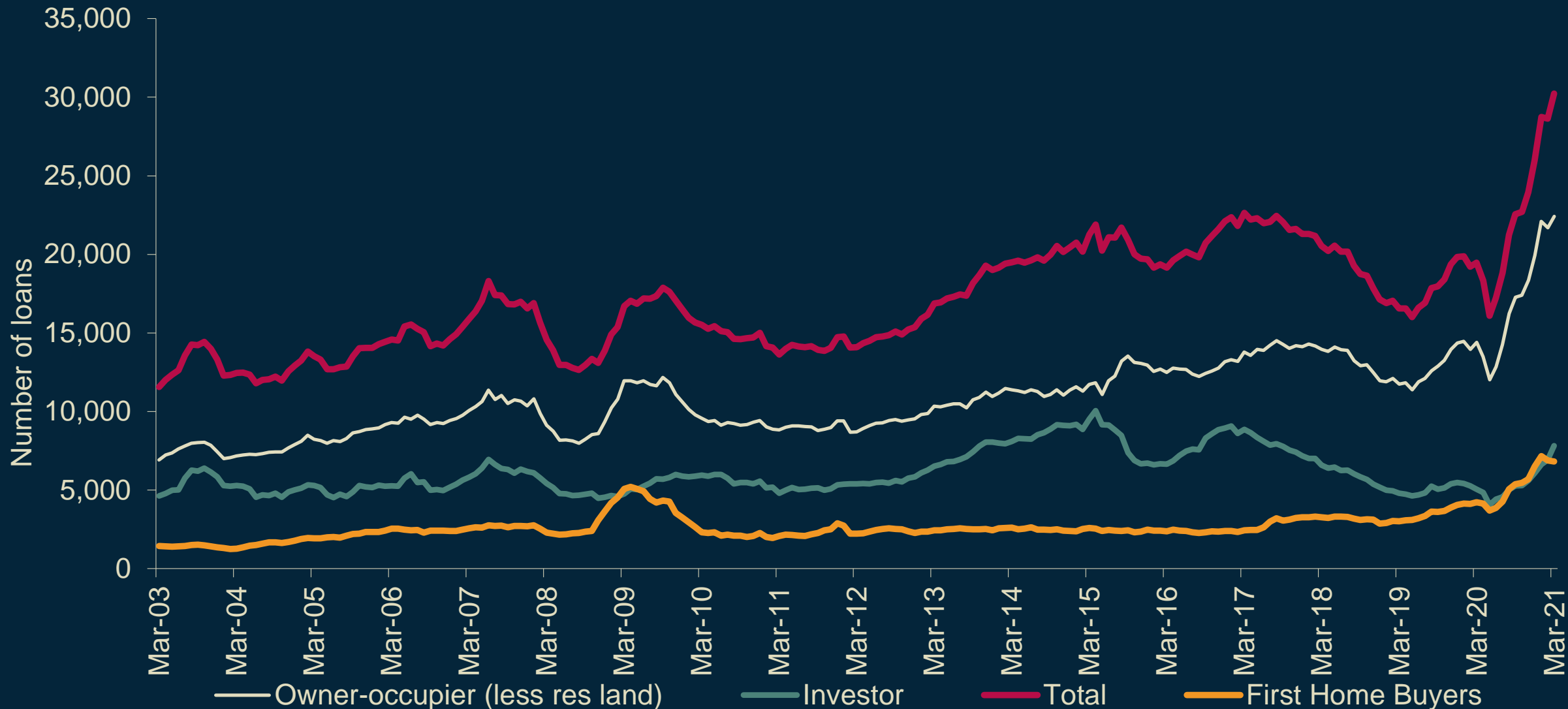

## New loans for Housing (value, \$m)

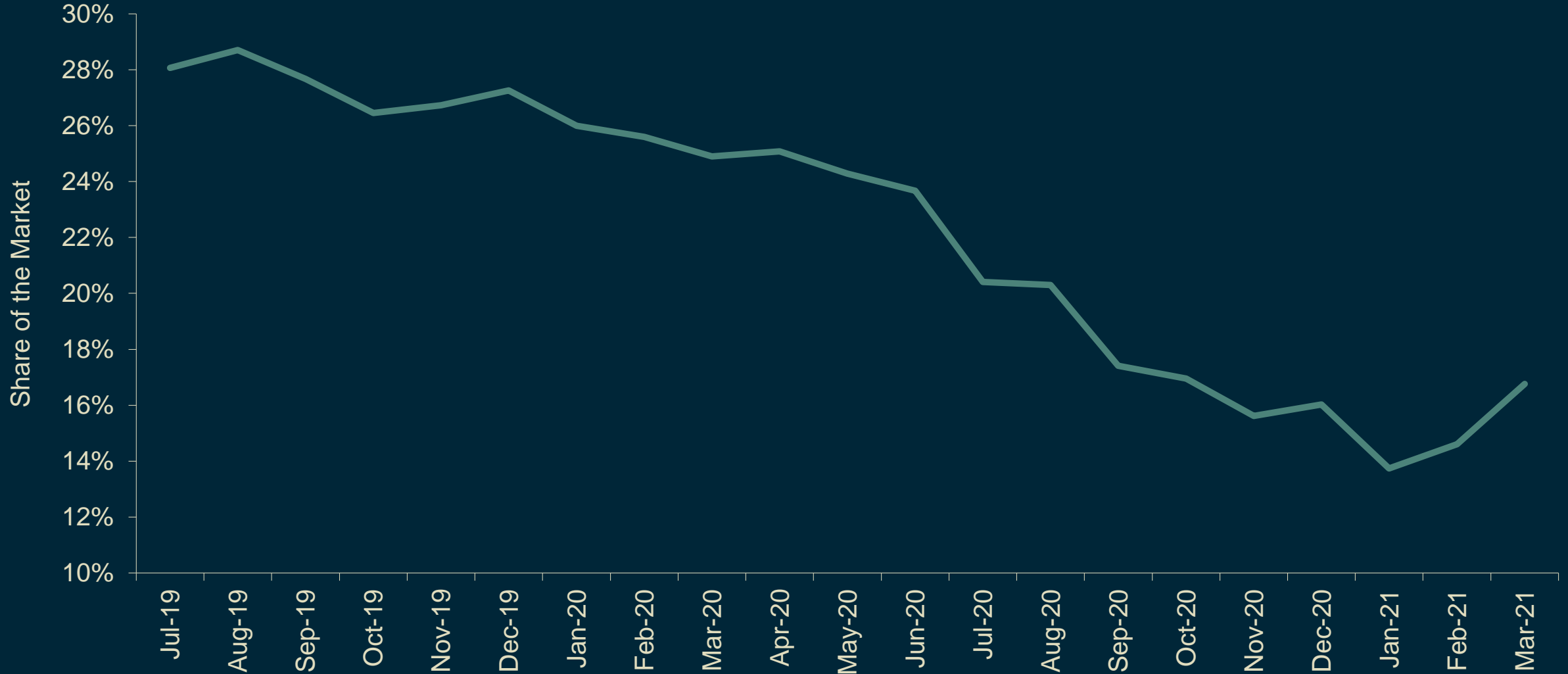

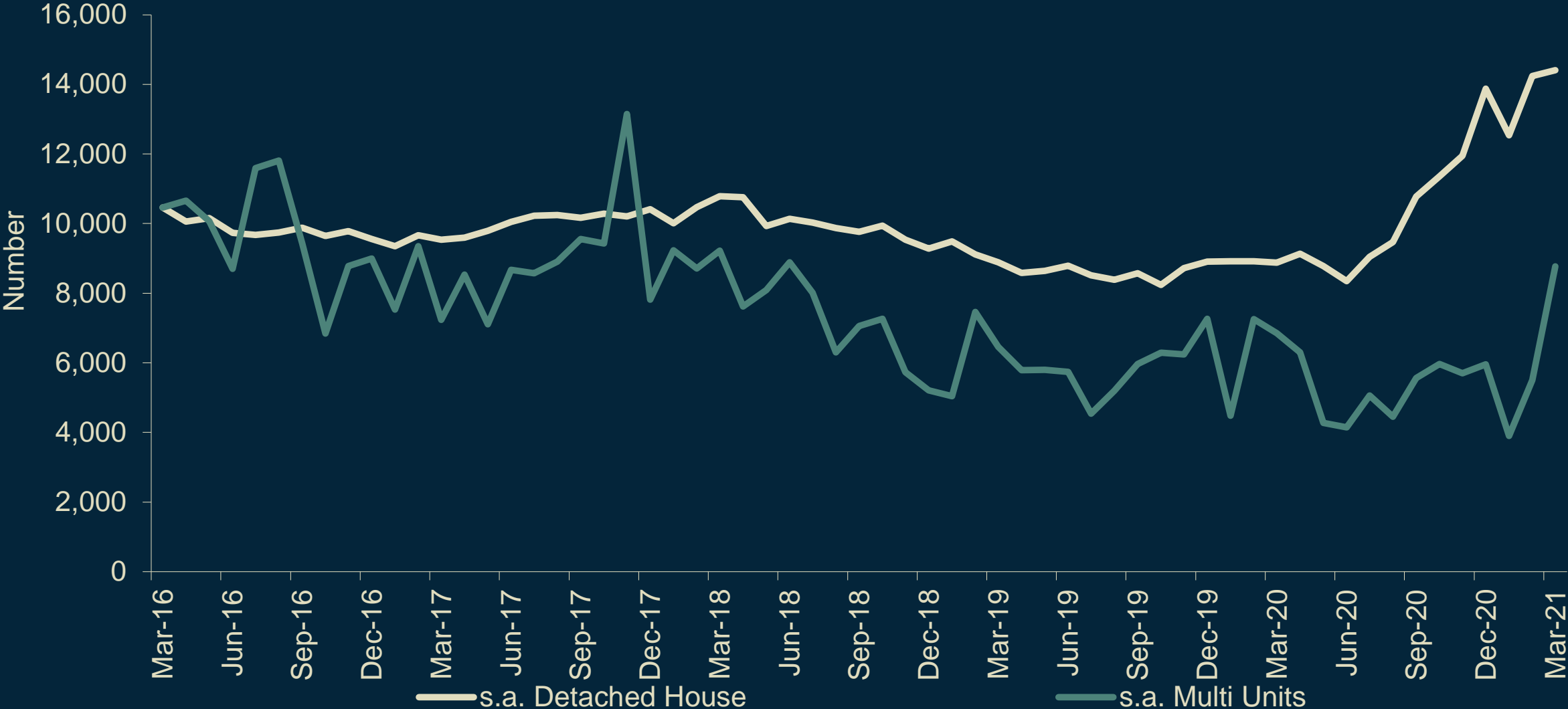

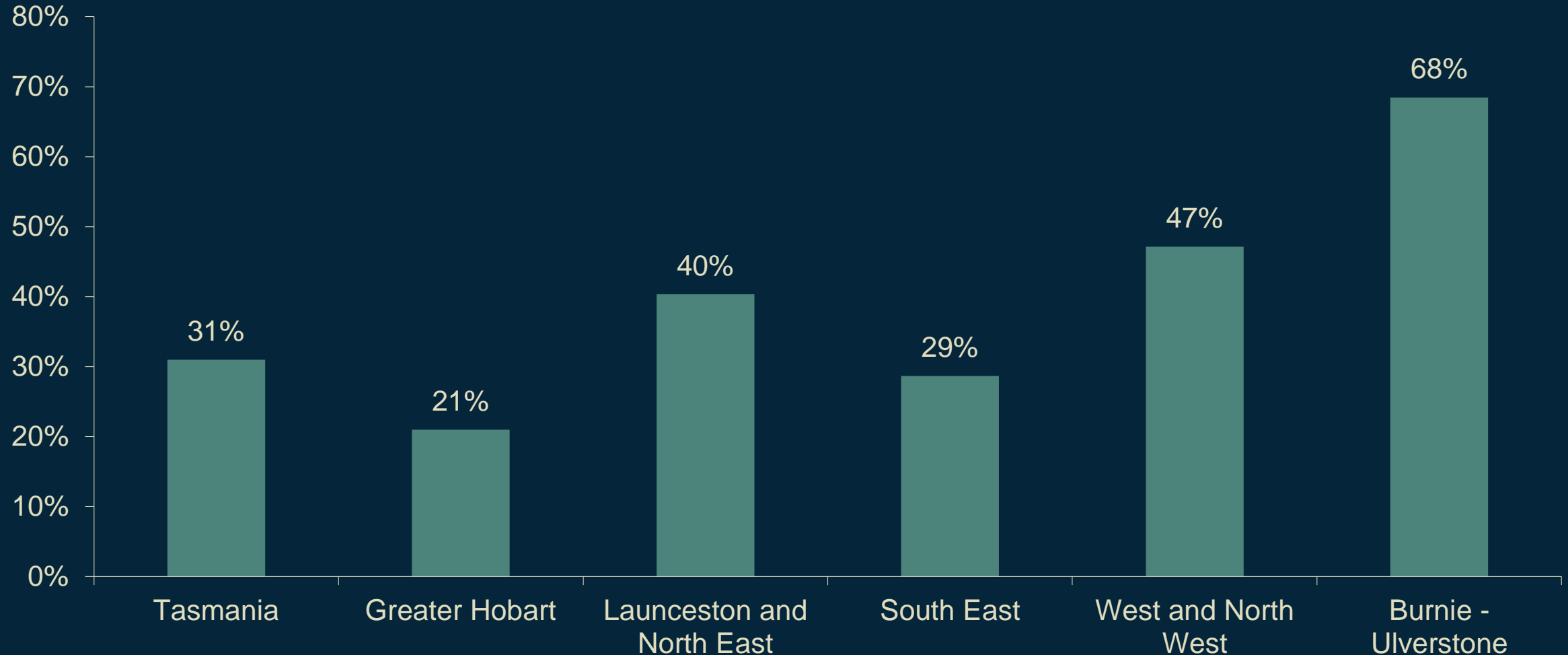

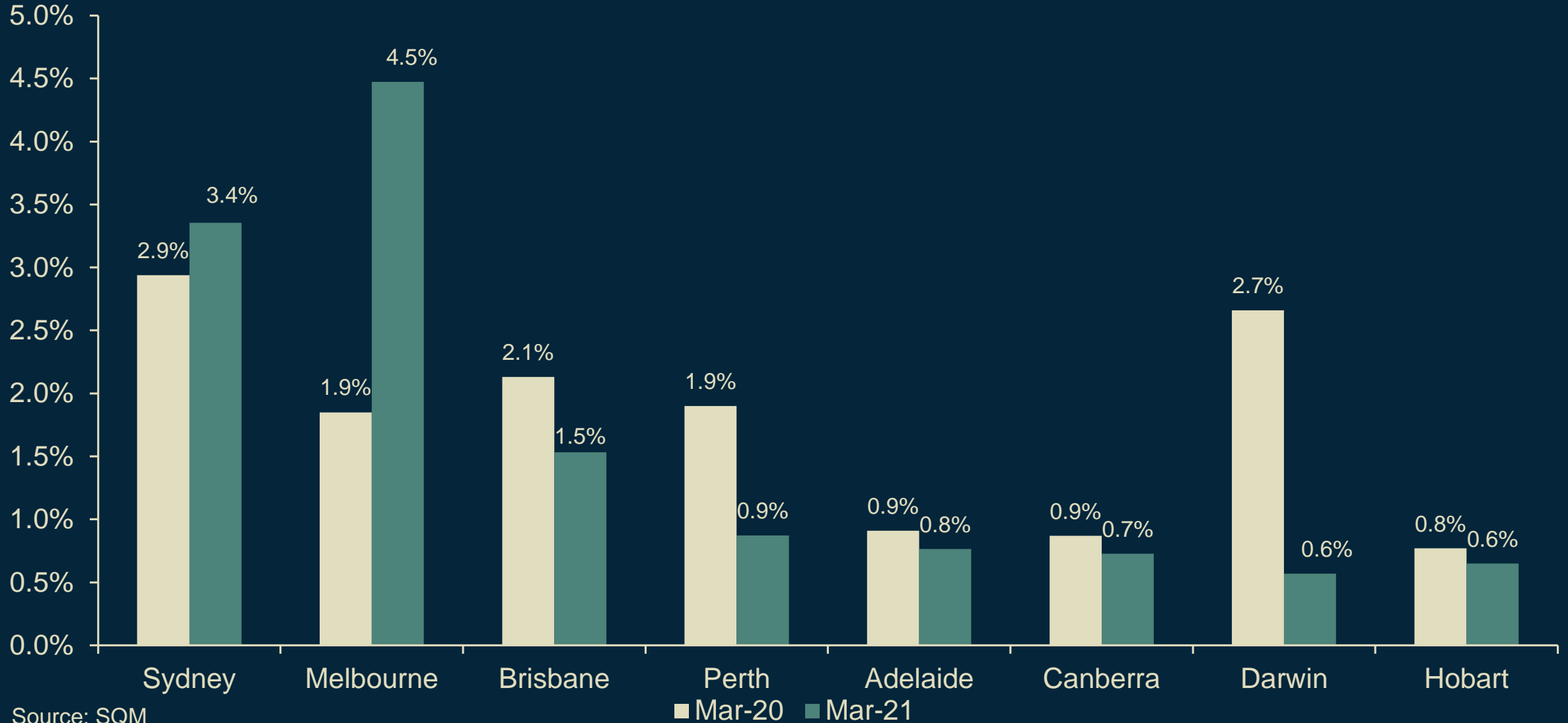
Change in Detached House Approvals - 12 months to Mar 2020 & 12 months to Mar 2021

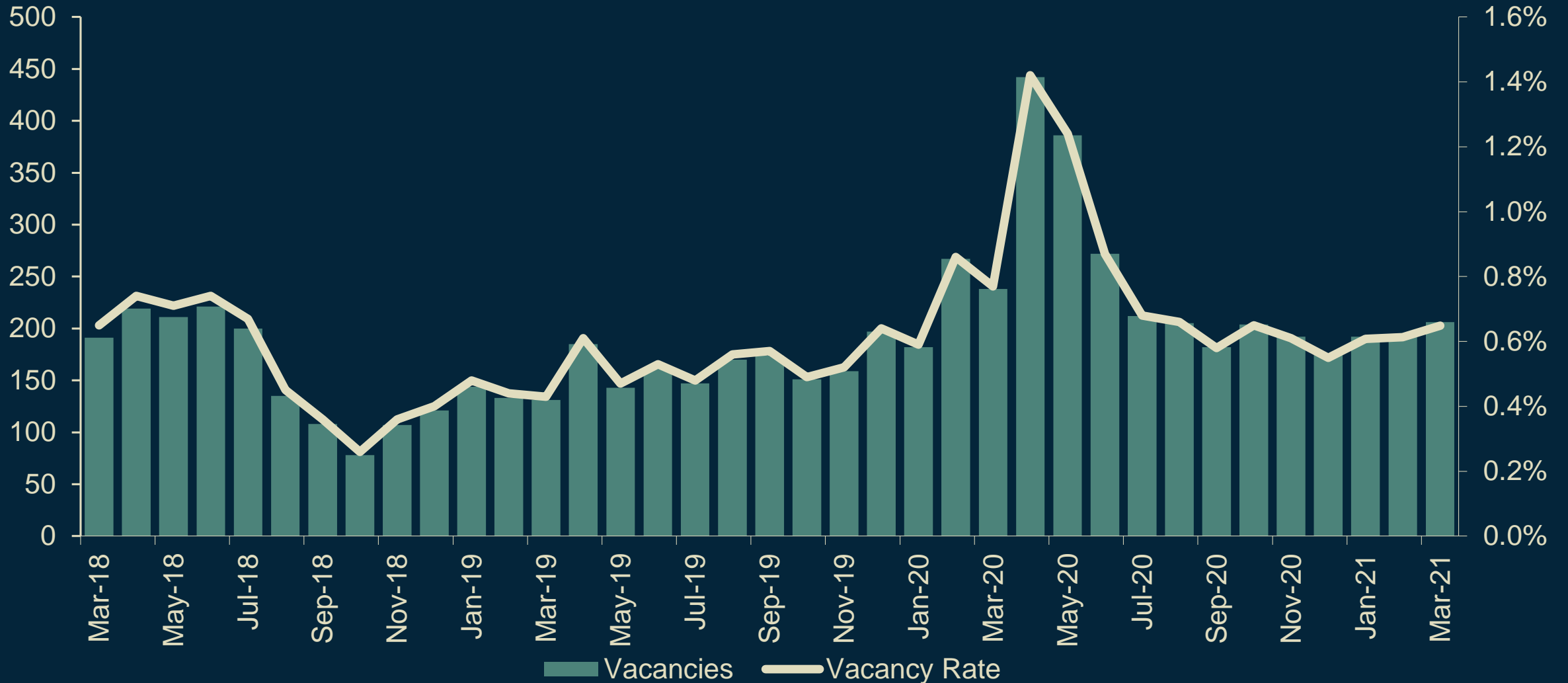
## Rental Vacancy Rates by City

## Median Weekly Asking Rents - March Qtr 2021

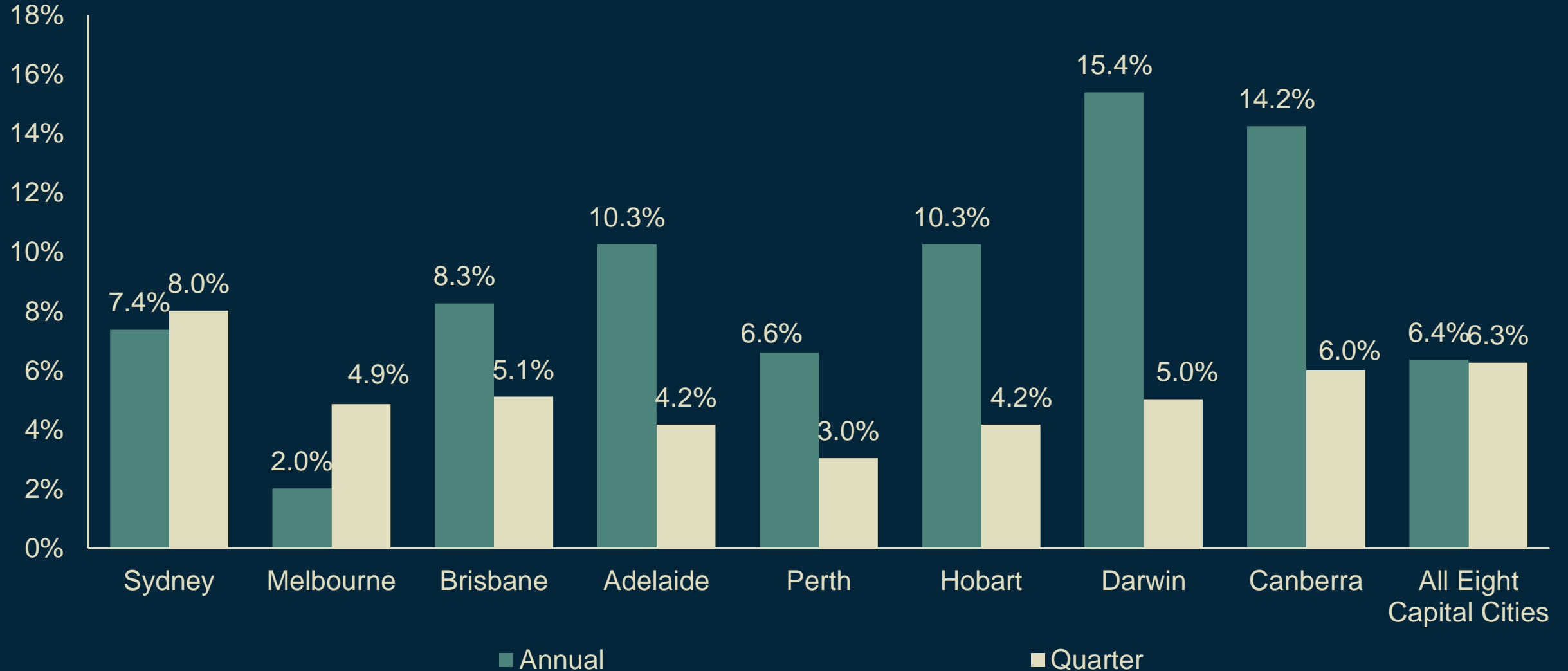

## Dwelling Price Growth Rate by Capital City, April 2021

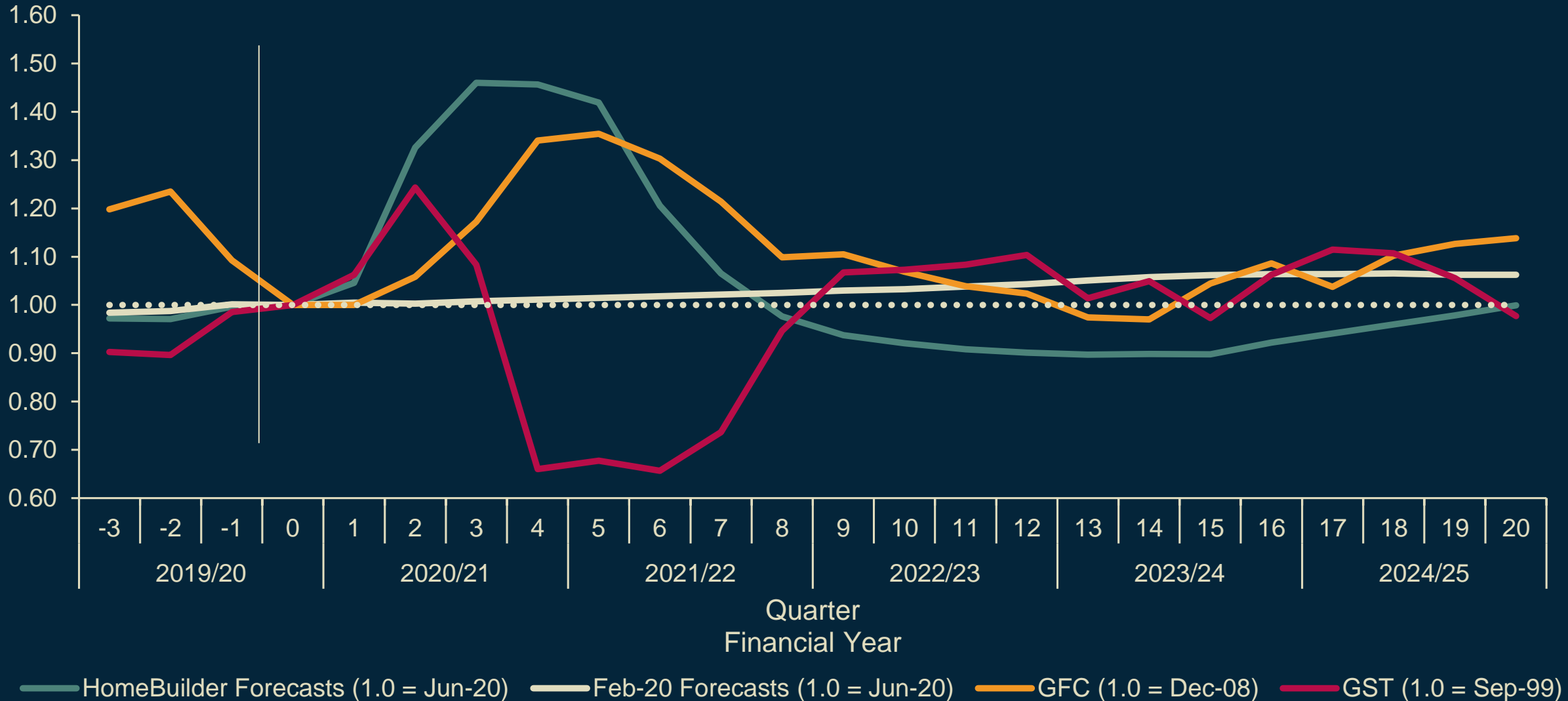

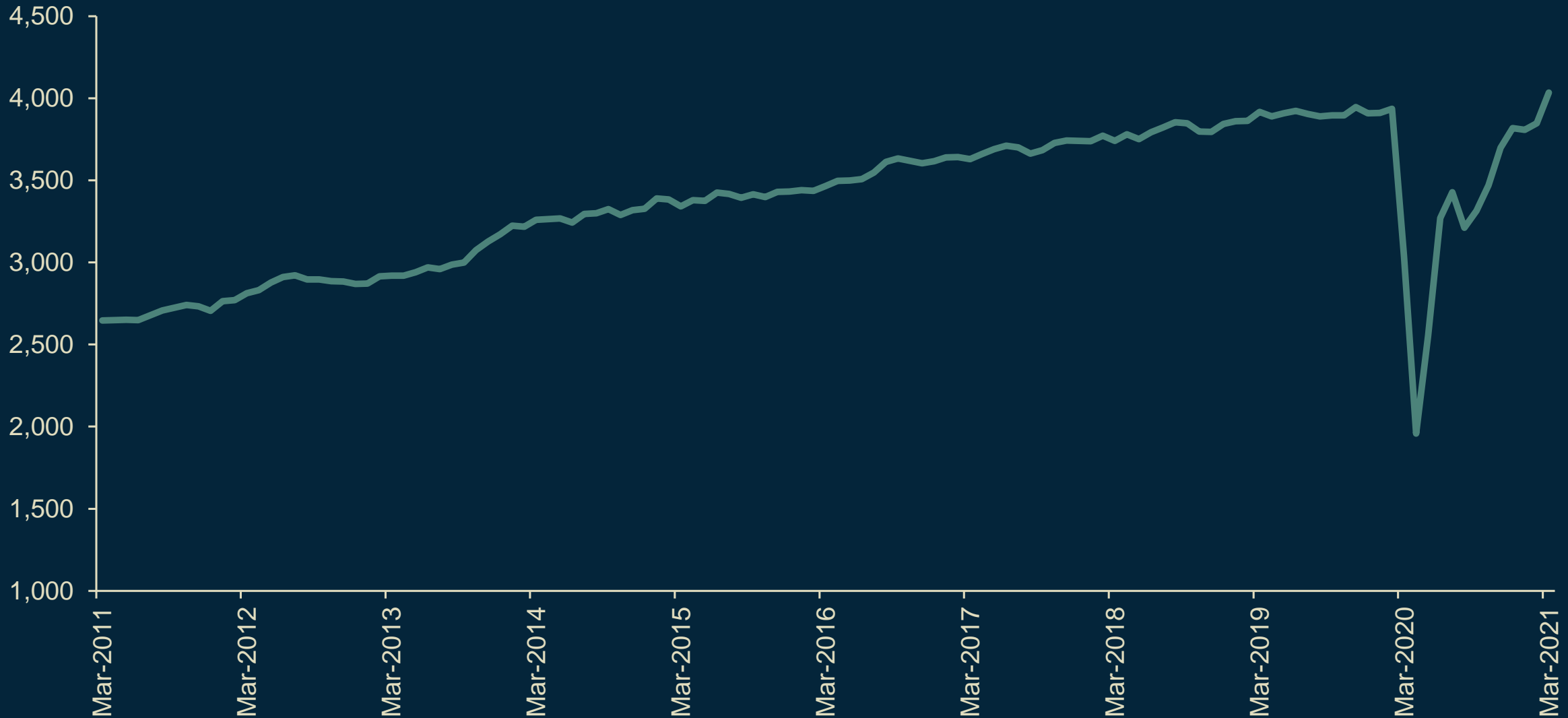

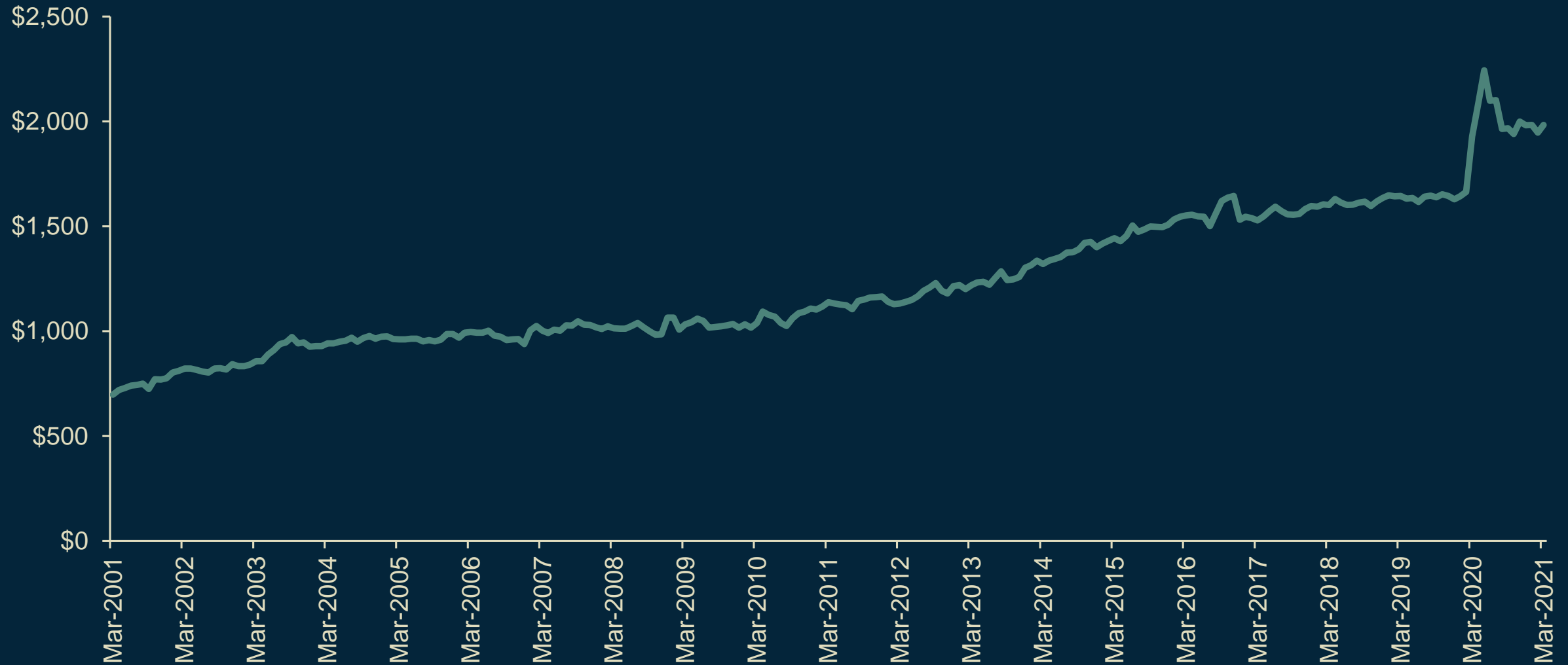

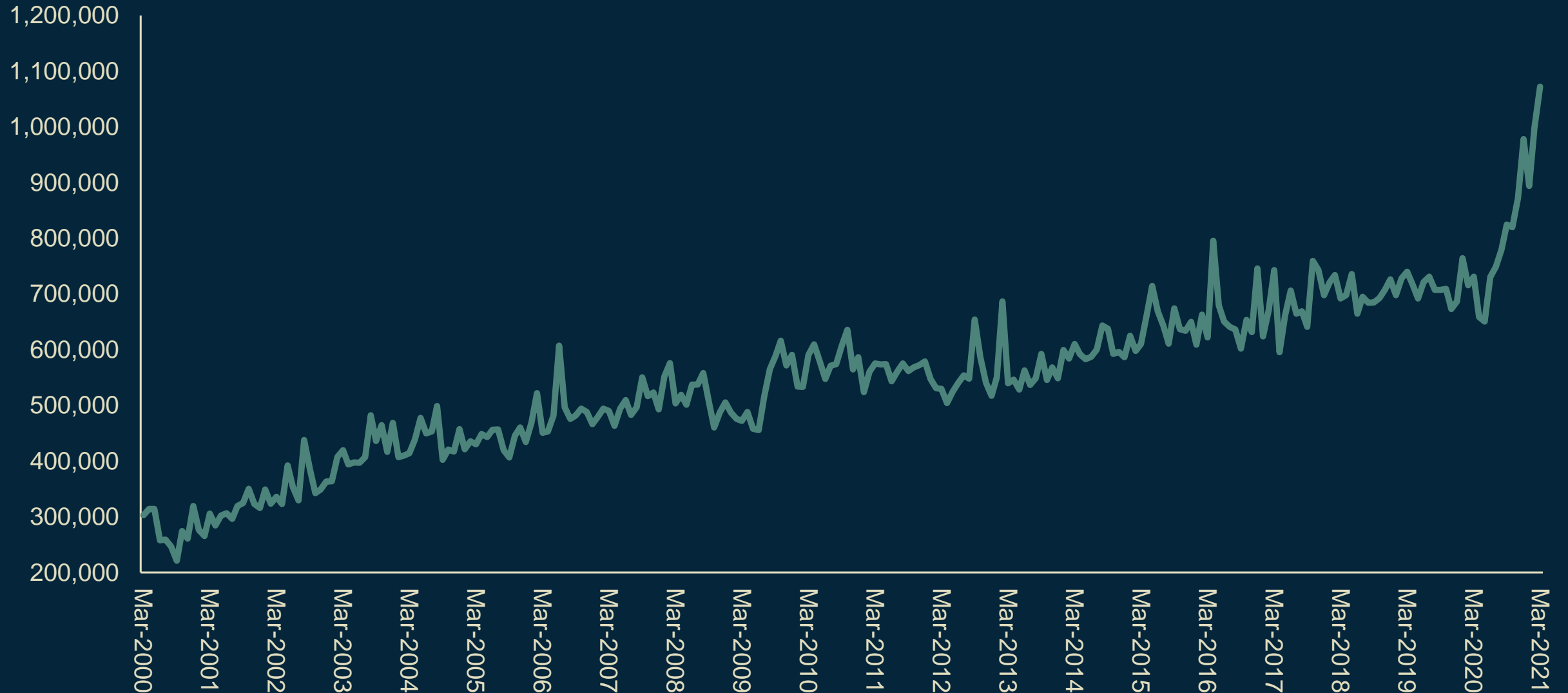

## Value of Building Approvals for Renovations (\$,000), Australia

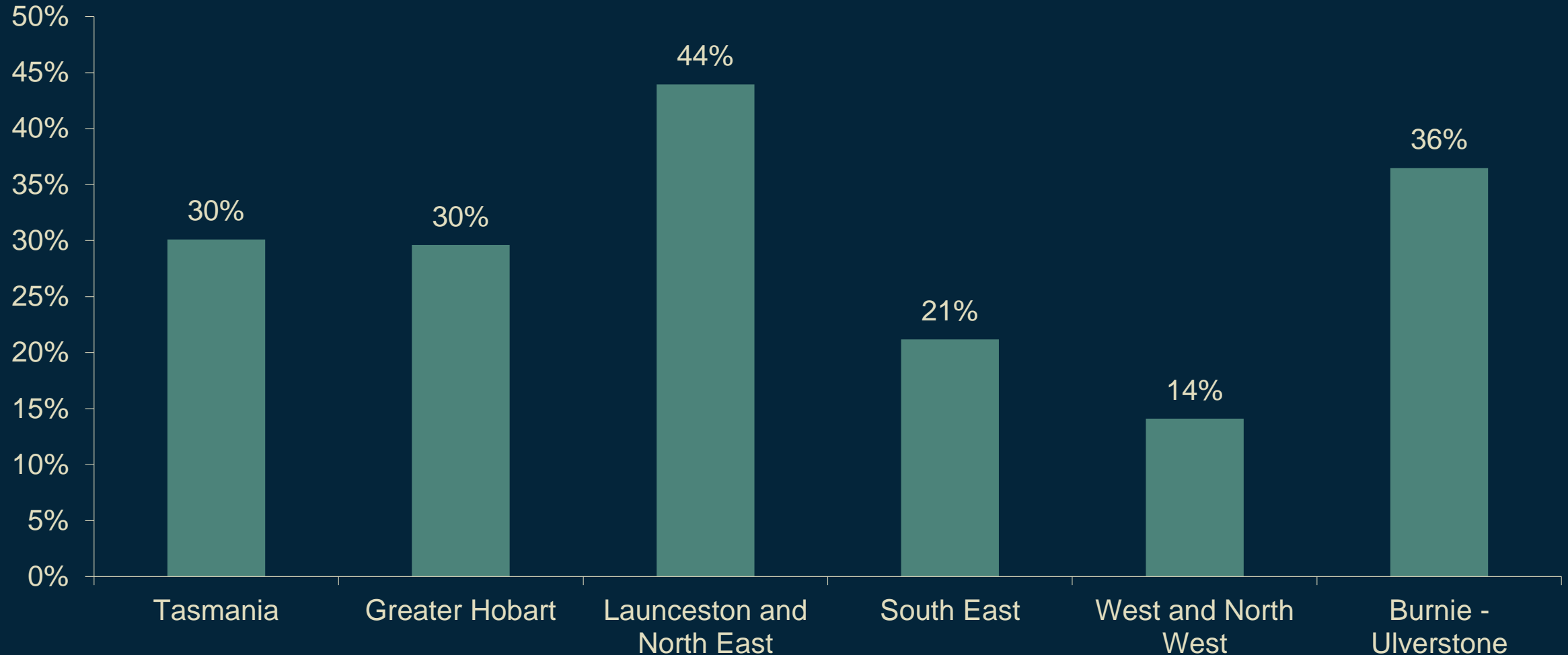

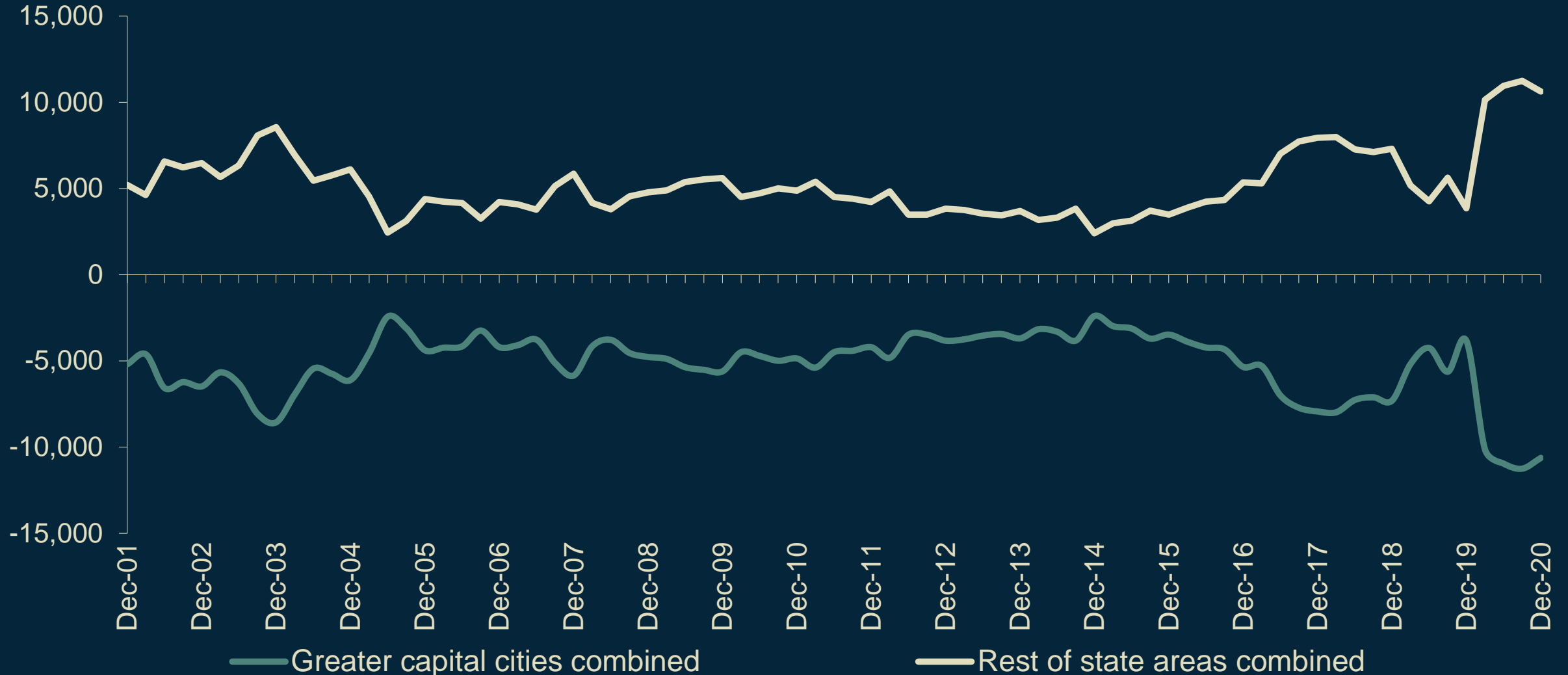

## Capital Cities and Regions, Net Internal Migration Estimates

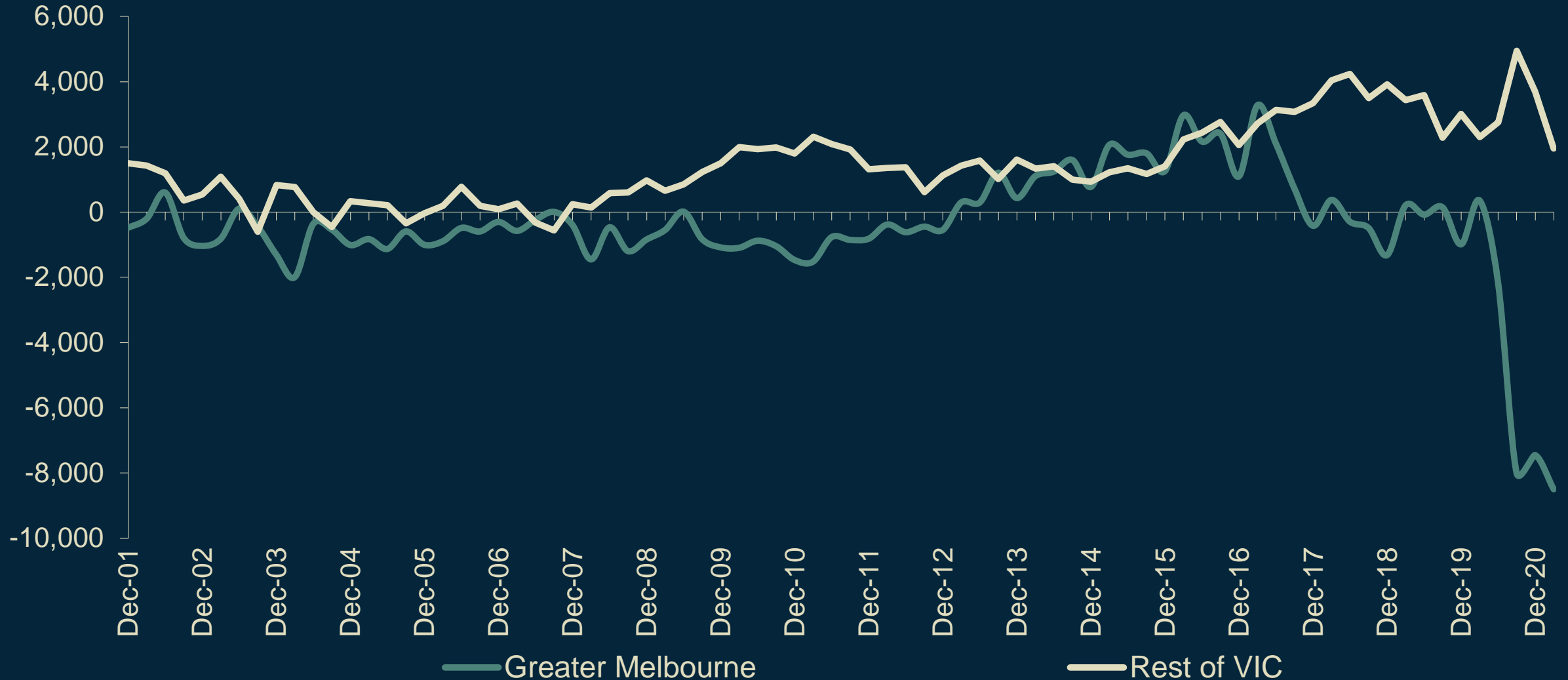

## Victorian Net Internal Migration Estimates

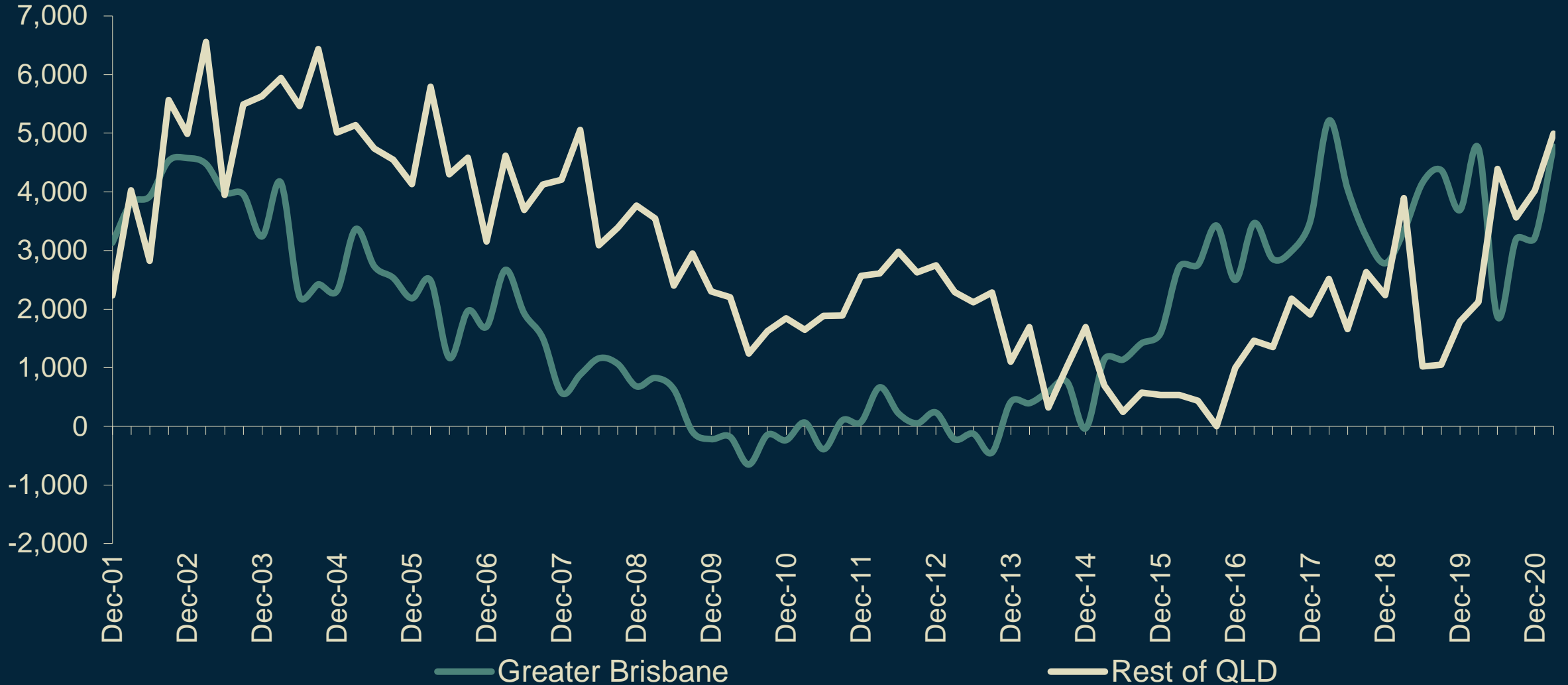

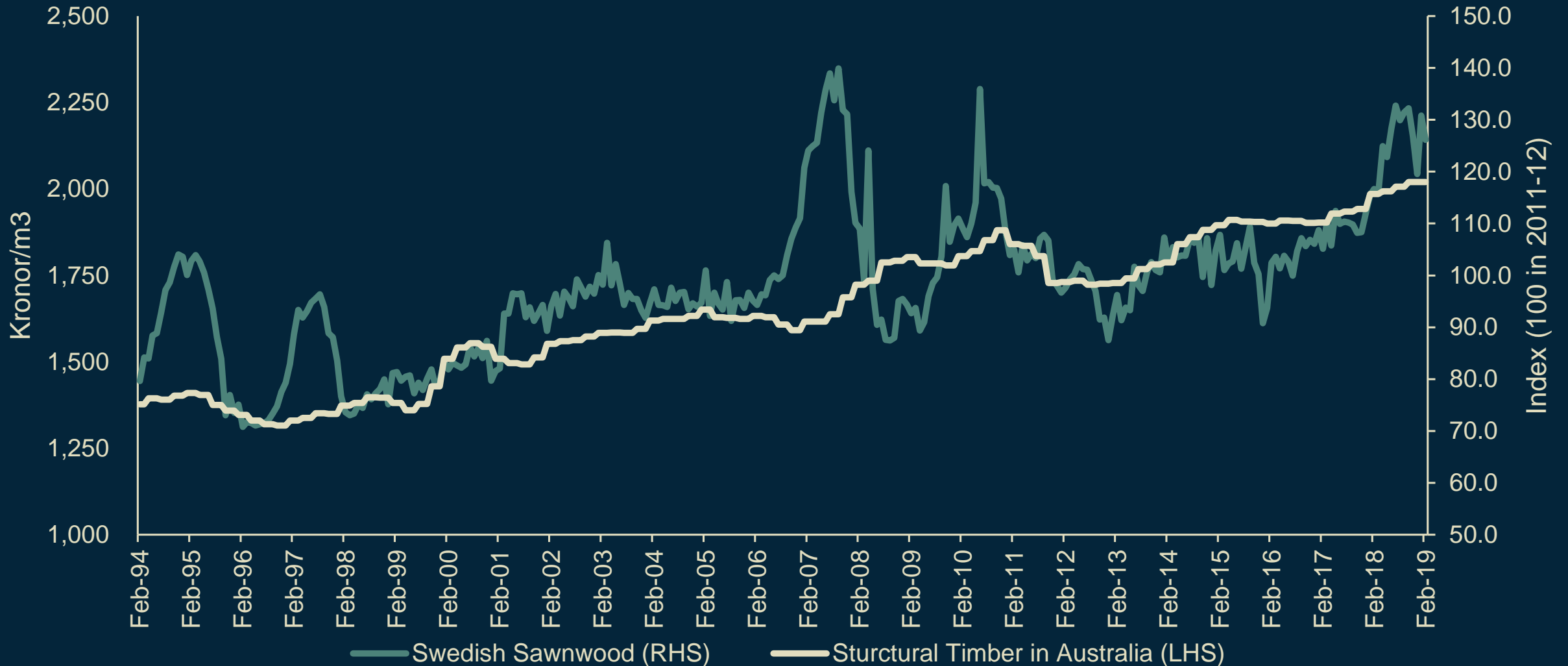

## Average Monthly Price of Sawnwood Exported from Sweden

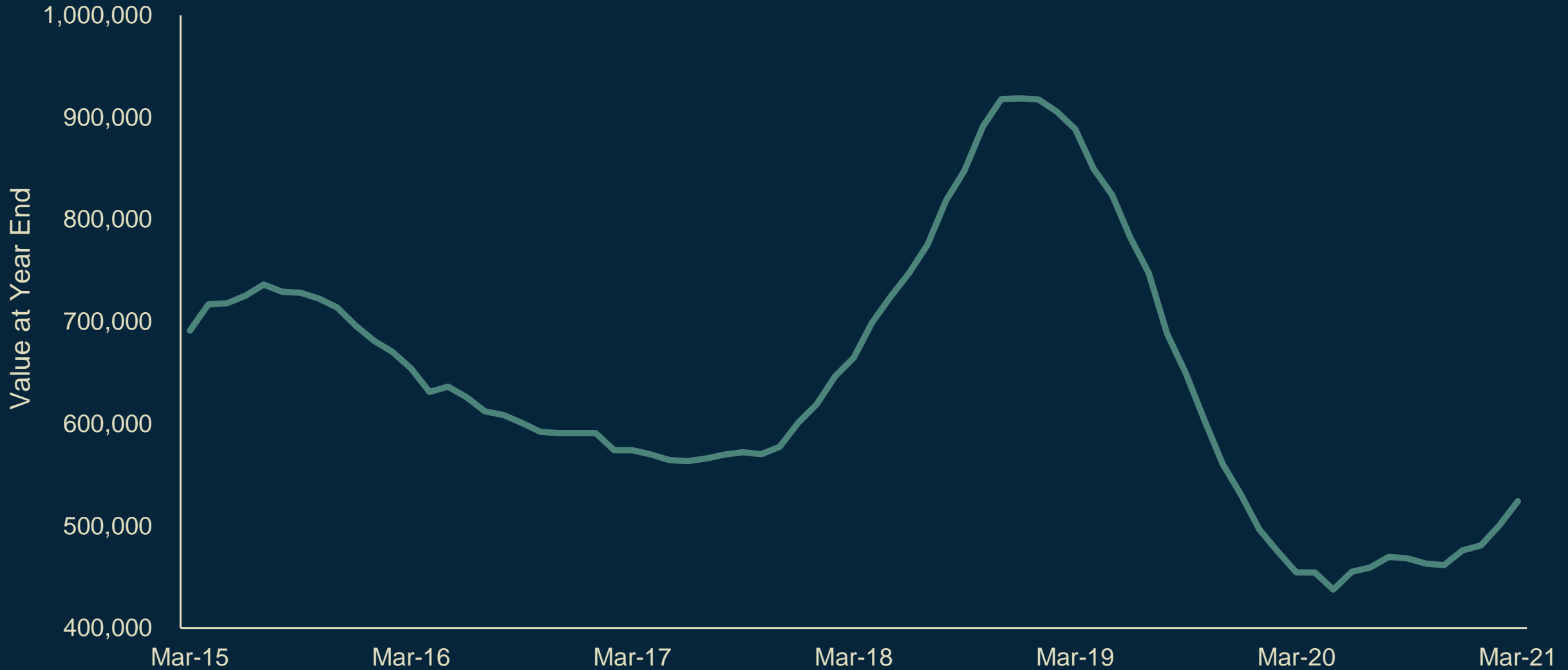

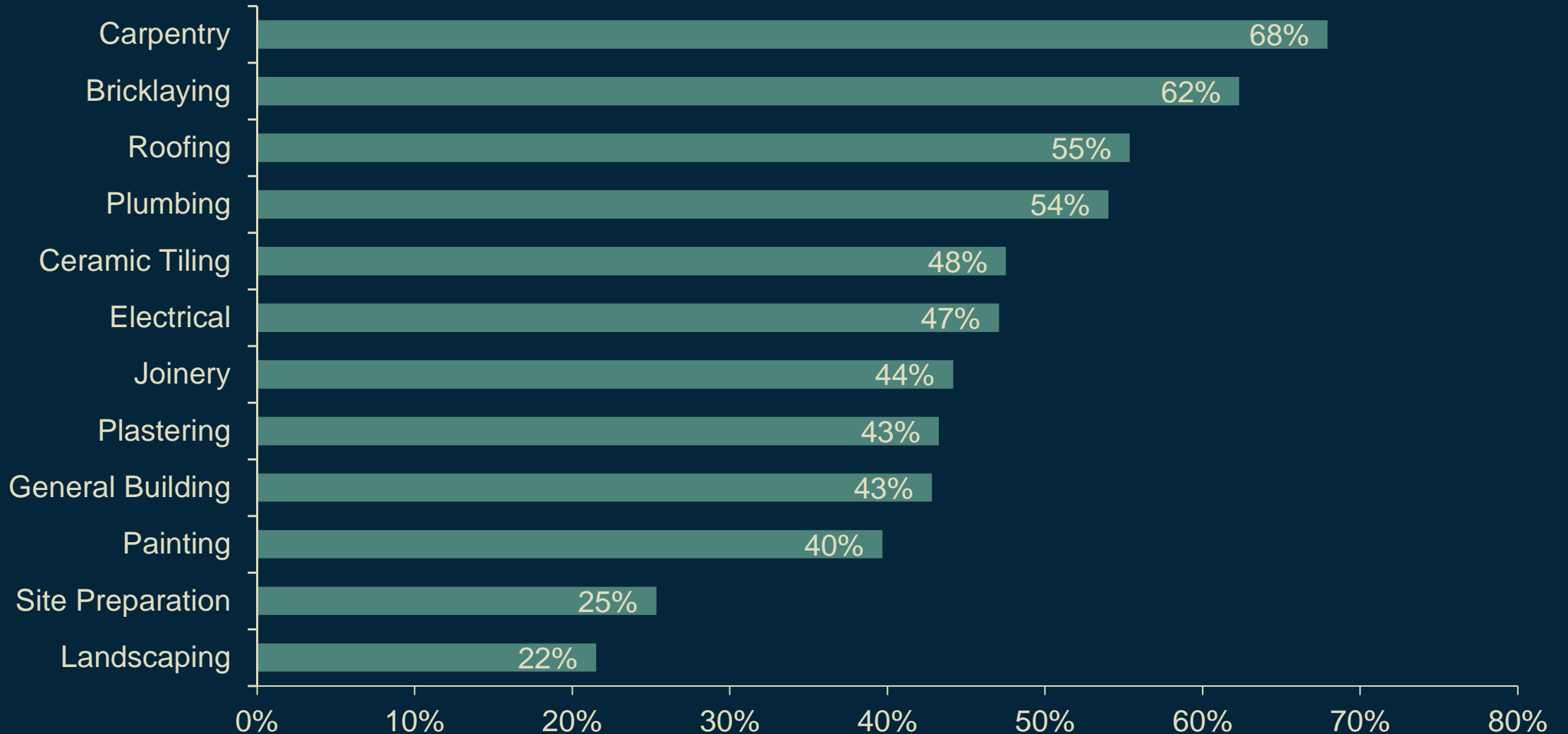
