HIA-CSR Hunter Housing Awards Winners Announced

For the first time in the events 20 year history the winners and finalists at the prestigious 2020 HIA-CSR Hunter Housing and Kitchen & Bathroom Awards ceremony have been announced online this afternoon.

Held before an online crowd of industry leaders and peers that operate across the Hunter and Central Coast regions, the awards acknowledge the talent of builders, contractors, designers and manufacturers who plan and construct quality new homes, townhouses, renovations, kitchens and bathrooms.

Judged by industry professionals, winners were selected in 29 separate categories, with Paterson Builders taking out the coveted HIA-CSR Hunter Home of the Year award.

In the Kitchen and Bathroom categories ‘Kitchen Project of the Year’ was awarded to Sensational Kitchens and Rustic Touch took out ‘Bathroom Project of the Year’.

Mr Jennion congratulated all 2020 entrants. “HIA is delighted with the exceptional quality of entries and level of competition this year. In a year that has thrown up many challenges all winners and finalists should be proud to have reached the pinnacle of excellence as demonstrated in these awards,” he said.

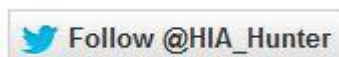
