The Australian building and construction industry is a large, diverse and exciting industry which provides endless opportunities to change and improve the world around us.

By joining one of Australia's largest industries you have chosen a career that's challenging, exciting and rewarding. You will also be joining an industry that's respected around the globe.

As a **tiler**, you lay ceramic, marble, porcelain, glass and other types of tiles on external and internal walls and floors to provide decorative and protective finishes to new homes, buildings and swimming pools. You can also carry out renovation work to existing buildings. You may be required to examine plans, measure and mark surfaces to be covered, and lay out work.

You can work for a company, which subcontracts tiling work within the building industry or employed by large contractors. Eventually you can be self-employed.
