MAKING SPACE ON SITE: COVID Safety Plan for <u>occupied</u> renovation sites in Greater Sydney



In line with NSW public health orders all residential building work on occupied home renovation sites in Greater Sydney must meet the following work, health and safety requirements to limit the risk of COVID-19.

ANYONE ENTERING THIS HOME MUST FOLLOW THE COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN MEASURES SET OUT BELOW.

1 The number of people on this renovation site must be limited to ensure that:

• no more workers are onsite than permitted by the NSW Government Public Health Orders.

All workers entering this site must scan and complete the TWO QR codes provided on this site:

• Service NSW COVID-19 check-in for this site

• HIA COVID-19 Site Induction for small construction sites in Greater Sydney

The HIA COVID-19 Site Induction requires every person attending site to confirm the following:

- You have not been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19
- You are not a close or casual contact of a person with a positive COVID-19 test required to isolate
- You feel well today and have no cold or flu symptoms or other symptoms of COVID-19
- You have read and understand the COVID-19 Safety Plan for this site.

All workers entering this site must comply with the following government safety measures at all times:

- where practicable, remain completely separate from the occupiers at all times
- adopt the **1.5 metre social distancing requirement** wherever practical
- adhere to the **1 person per 4 square metre rule** in enclosed or internal work spaces
- wear face masks where other personal protective equipment is not being worn and it is practical to wear a mask for the work being carried out
- practice good hand hygiene
- report to the site supervisor any concerns in relation to the availability of **personal hygiene and site cleaning products** and any **shared facilities**

All deliveries to site must be managed to facilitate contactless deliveries and minimise contact between delivery drivers and workers on site:

- All delivery drivers must wear masks while attending site or communicating with workers on site
- Where practicable, all delivery drivers must remain in their vehicles if not required to assist with unloading materials
- Where a driver is required to unload and it is practicable to do so, no other person should touch the vehicle
- All workers must maintain at least **3 metres physical** distance from delivery drivers
