

MAKING SPACE ON SITE:

COVID Safety Plan for small construction sites in Greater Sydney



In line with NSW public health orders all residential building work on new home building sites and **unoccupied** home renovation sites in Greater Sydney must meet the following work, health and safety requirements to limit the risk of COVID-19.

ALL BUILDERS, TRADE CONTRACTORS, DELIVERY STAFF AND PROFESSIONAL SERVICES PROVIDERS THAT ATTEND THIS BUILDING SITE MUST FOLLOW THE COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN MEASURES SET OUT BELOW.

1 The number of people on this building site must be limited to ensure that:

- only one trade team is present on this site at any time
- no person enters the site that has also worked at more than 5 different sites in the last 7 days

Note: A person is permitted to attend the site for a short period of time if they are a site supervisor, certifier/inspector, engineer, architect or building designer, delivery driver or specialist installers that work on their own.

2 All workers entering this site must scan and complete the TWO QR codes provided on this site:

- Service NSW COVID-19 check-in for this site
- HIA COVID-19 Site Induction for small construction sites in Greater Sydney

The HIA COVID-19 Site Induction requires every person attending site to confirm the following:

- You do not live in one of the currently restricted local government areas
- You have not been in contact with anyone who has COVID-19 or is a close or casual contact of a person with a positive COVID-19 test
- You feel well today and have no cold or flu symptoms or other symptoms of COVID-19
- You have not attended more than 5 work sites in the last 7 days
- You have read and understand the COVID-19 Safety Plan for this site

3 All workers entering this site must comply with the following government safety measures at all times:

- adopt the 1.5 metre social distancing requirement wherever practical
- adhere to the 1 person per 4 square metre rule in enclosed or internal work spaces
- wear face masks where other personal protective equipment is not being worn and it is practical to wear a mask for the work being carried out
- practice good hand hygiene
- report to the site supervisor any concerns in relation to the availability of personal hygiene and site cleaning products and any shared facilities

4 All deliveries to site must be managed to facilitate contactless deliveries and minimise contact between delivery drivers and workers on site:

- All delivery drivers must wear masks while attending site or communicating with workers on site
- Where practicable, all delivery drivers must remain in their vehicles if not required to assist with unloading materials
- Where a driver is required to unload and it is practicable to do so, no other person should touch the vehicle
- All workers must maintain at least 3 metres physical distance from delivery drivers
